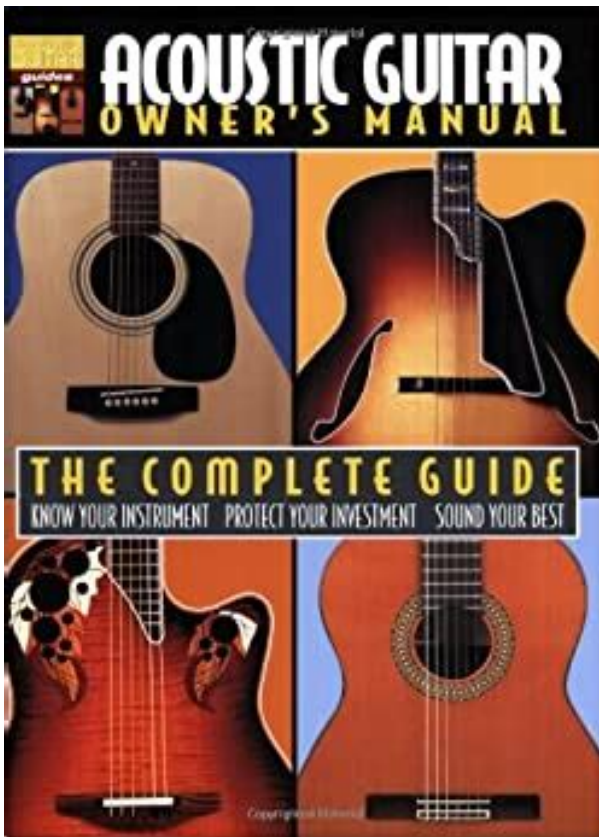

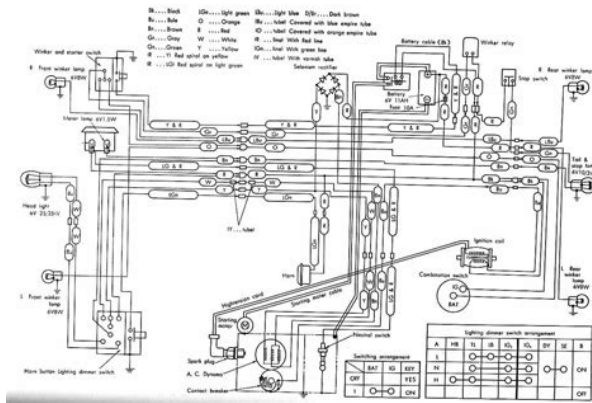

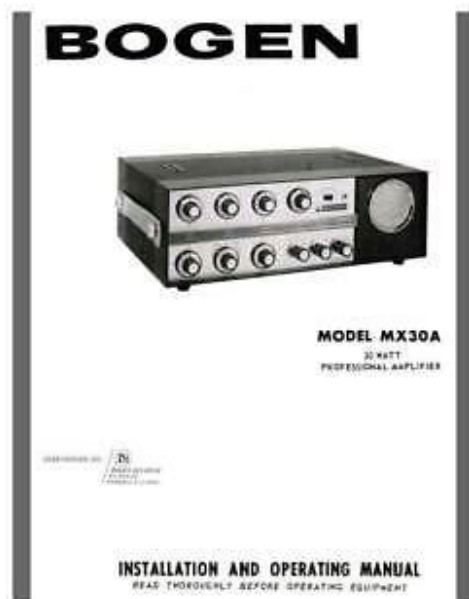

UNPACKING

After unpacking the Melody, inspect it carefully for any signs of damage in transit. Your unit was subjected to many inspections and tests, and then carefully packed. If any damage is visible, notify your dealer immediately. If the unit was shipped to you, notify the transportation company at once.
